ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION A-19361

FOR A PERMIT TO IMPOUND WATER

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On May 7, 2015, Bryan D. Kratky, on behalf of Lamp Rynearson & Associates and Sanitary Improvement District No. 472, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19361 for a permit to impound water in Shadow View 2nd Addition Reservoir from a tributary to Boxelder Creek for the purpose of erosion control and water quality located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 15 North, Range 11 East of the 6th P.M. in Douglas County.
2. The status of application A-19361 is pending.
3. A review of Department records indicates Shadow View 2nd Addition Reservoir is on-channel and the normal storage pool is 11.2 acre-feet. Therefore, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-241(2) a permit to impound water is not required.
4. On August 19, 2015, Bryan D. Kratky, on behalf of Lamp Rynearson & Associates and Sanitary Improvement District No. 472, filed correspondence in the Department requesting dismissal of application A-19361.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED application A-19361 is DISMISSED.
