APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19372

WATER DIVISION 1-F

BACKGROUND

1. On July 16, 2015, Glendon Reece and Lois Luthy and Kevin Spearman filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19372 for a Permit to Appropriate Water and map number 19297 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19372.
2. Construction has been completed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-19372 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is the South Fork of the Nemaha River.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of irrigation.
3. The priority date is July 16, 2015.
4. Only the land shown on map number 19297 may be irrigated under appropriation A-19372.
5. Water diverted under appropriation A-19372 shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated. Total annual volume of water diverted may not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated and the least amount that can be beneficially used.
6. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. The statutes include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

7. The appropriator must comply with the following deadlines:
- A. The appropriation is not considered perfected until water has been beneficially applied for the purpose stated in this approval. The water appropriated under A-19372 must be beneficially used by September 1, 2018.
 - B. After September 1, 2018, a field investigation will be conducted to determine the acres irrigated, after which an order of cancellation will be issued for any unused portions of appropriation A-19372.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations. If in the future you are not able to divert sufficient amounts of water, and if there are junior appropriations upstream, you may call for water by contacting your local field office.

The applicant and any person with sufficient legal interest who has been or may be substantially affected by this order may request a contested case hearing in accordance with the *Neb. Admin. Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure Title 454 Admin. Code Chapter 7*. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (Nebraska State Office Building, 4th Floor, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
