ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATIONS FOR A PERMIT TO TRANSFER GROUND WATER
TO AN ADJOINING STATE AND FOR AN INDUSTRIAL TRANSFER PERMIT


The Director of the Department of Natural Resources (Department) dismisses Applications TA-53 and I-24, submitted by Northern Natural Gas Company (Applicant), for permits to withdraw and transport ground water to Iowa for industrial use.

The Applicant provided written notice to the Department that an alternative source of water would be used to complete the proposed hydrostatic testing project, such that the ground water requested under Applications TA-53 and I-24 was no longer needed.

It is therefore ORDERED that Applications TA-53 and I-24 are DISMISSED.
