APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-5175 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION D-473

WATER DIVISION 2-D

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation D-473 is held by Tony and Deanna Johnson.
2. Appropriation D-473 has a priority date of December 1, 1894, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the land depicted on map number 3819 approved by Order dated March 28, 1928, as described below. The water may be diverted from Spring Creek at a point of diversion located on the north bank of the stream in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 32 North, Range 52 West of the 6th P.M. in Dawes County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated from all points of diversion.

3. On September 23, 2014, Tony Johnson filed application EXT-5175 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation D-473.
4. On February 2, 2015, Tony and Deanna Johnson filed map number 19080 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation D-473 through transfer EXT-5175.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-5175 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 19080 are APPROVED.

2. Appropriation D-473 through transfer EXT-5175 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 90 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 19080, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from Spring Creek at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 32 North, Range 51 West of the 6th P.M. in Dawes County, as depicted on map number 19080. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 1.29 cfs (579 gallons per minute). The total volume may not exceed 3 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation D-473 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
