ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-17900

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-17900 is held by Gregory D. and Erin L. Stunkel.
2. Appropriation A-17900 has a priority date of August 3, 2000, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 32 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Mud (Beaver) Creek at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 15 North, Range 18 West of the 6th P.M. in Custer County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.46 cfs from all points of diversion.
