APPROVAL OF MAP 17365 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18636

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

1. On January 16, 2009, Midwest Tree Moving filed application A-18636 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On January 29, 2009, Midwest Tree Moving filed map number 17365 showing land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-18636.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17365 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18636 as depicted on map number 17365 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18636 is held by Midwest Tree Moving and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 21.7 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the right bank of the Missouri River at a point of diversion in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 9, Township 33 North, Range 1 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Cedar County at a maximum rate of 0.31 cubic foot per second (cfs) (139 gallons per minute). The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated and an annual volume not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18636.

Additional Information

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations and any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.
