APPROVAL OF MAP 17369 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18640

Background

1. On February 5, 2009, David J. and Sarah J. Anderson filed application A-18640 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On February 20, 2009, David J. and Sarah J. Anderson filed map number 17369 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18640.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17369 is APPROVED.
2. The following is a description of all the land which is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18640 as depicted on map number 17369 which is made a part of this Order.

3. David J. and Sarah J. Anderson are allowed to divert 37.1 acre-feet annually from (storage appropriation A-15990) located in the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 10, Township 34 North, Range 11 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Boyd County to irrigate the land described above. Appropriation A-18640 provides for an additional diversion of water from Anderson Reservoir to the prior storage-use appropriation A-16180. Total diversion from Anderson Reservoir for both appropriations should not exceed 178.6 acre-feet per year.

4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18640.
