APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-18659

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

1. On April 15, 2009, Russell Schmidt filed application A-18659 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On April 27, 2009, Russell Schmidt filed map number 17402 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18659.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-18659 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is a tributary to Antelope Creek.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of irrigation.
3. The priority date is April 15, 2009.
4. Only the land shown on map number 17402 may be irrigated under appropriation A-18659.
5. The rate of water that may be diverted under appropriation A-18659 shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated. Total annual volume of water diverted may not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
6. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
  - a. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - b. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
  - c. Getting approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

Deadlines

1. Construction of the diversion works must begin within six months of the signing date of this application approval. The appropriator must proceed diligently with the construction unless interrupted by some unavoidable and natural cause.
