APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-18668

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

1. On June 15, 2009, Stan and Cheryl Sudbeck filed application A-18668 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On July 8, 2009, Stan Sudbeck filed map number 17443 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18668.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-18668 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is a tributary to East Bow Creek.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of irrigation.
3. The priority date is June 15, 2009.
4. Only the land shown on map number 17443 may be irrigated under appropriation A-18668.
5. The rate that water may be diverted under appropriation A-18668 shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated. Total annual volume of water diverted may not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
6. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - b. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - c. Getting approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
