APPROVAL OF MAP 17566 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18679

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

1. On October 19, 2009, Robert Brummels filed application A-18679 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On December 29, 2009, Robert Brummels filed map number 17566 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18679.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17566 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18679 as depicted on map number 17566 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18679 is held by Robert Brummels and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 229.4 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Pearl Creek at a point of diversion in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34, Township 30 North, Range 1 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Cedar County, at a maximum rate of 3.28 cubic foot per second (cfs) (1,472 gallons per minute). The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated and an annual volume not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
