APPROVAL OF MAP 17604 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18684

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

1. On December 16, 2009, J. Douglas Nelson, President, Green Island Farms Inc., filed application A-18684 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On January 21, 2010, J. Douglas Nelson filed map number 17604 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18684.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17604 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18684 as depicted on map number 17604 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18684 is held by Green Island Farms Inc., and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 19.0 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Antelope Creek at a point of diversion on the left bank of the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 33 North, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M. in Cedar County, at a maximum rate of 0.27 cubic foot per second (cfs) (121 gallons per minute). The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated and an annual volume not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.

4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18684.
