APPROVAL OF MAP 17649 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18700

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On April 12, 2010, Arlene J. Cosgrove filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18700 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On June 1, 2010, Arlene J. Cosgrove filed map number 17649 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18700.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17649 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18700 as depicted on map number 17649 which is made a part of this Order.


Township 15 North, Range 12 East of the

Section 36: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  1

3. Appropriation A-18700 is held by Arlene J. Cosgrove and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 1 acre of land described above. The water may be diverted from Little Papillion Creek at a point of diversion in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36, Township 15 North, Range 12 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Douglas County, at a maximum rate of 0.01 cubic foot per second (cfs) (4 gallons per minute). The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated and an annual volume not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18700.
