ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-2398

WATER DIVISION 2-A

Background

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-2398 is held by Joe E. and Debra J. Grantzinger.
2. Appropriation A-2398 with a priority date of June 4, 1934, authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 10 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Victoria Creek at a point of diversion located on the east bank of the stream in the SW¹/₄NW¹/₄ of Section 6, Township 19 North, Range 20 West of the 6th P.M. in Custer County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.14 cfs.


