APPROVAL OF PETITION P-614 AND MAP TO CHANGE THE LOCATION OF

DIVERSION FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-3682

WATER DIVISION 2-A

Background

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show surface water appropriation A-3682 is held by Ronald D. and Karen N. Scott.
2. Appropriation A-3682 has a priority date of February 7, 1944, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of 68.1 acres of land. The water may be diverted from the Cedar River at a point of diversion located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 18 North, Range 7 West of the 6th P.M. in Nance County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.49 cfs (220 gallons per minute).
3. Ronald D. Scott filed petition P-614 for a permit to change the location of diversion for the land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-3682.
4. Map number 17319 shows the location of the proposed pump site and the land to be irrigated under appropriation A-3682 through petition P-614.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Petition P-614 for a permit to change the location of diversion and map number 17319 are APPROVED.
2. Appropriation A-3682 through petition P-614 is now A-3682R.

3. Appropriation A-3682R authorizes the use of water to irrigate 68.1 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 17319, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from the Cedar River at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Township 17 North, Range 7 West of the 6th P.M. in Nance County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.49 cfs. The total volume may not exceed 3 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year.

4. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-3682 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
5. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following.
- Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

Additional Information

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
