ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-7442

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-7442 is held by Gary W. and Joanna J. Cook.
2. Appropriation A-7442 has a priority date of May 4, 1955, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 16 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Mud (Beaver) Creek at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 16 North, Range 19 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Custer County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 110 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.15 cfs.
