APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-4673 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-12215

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-12215 is held by Vernon D. Curtis.
2. Appropriation A-12215 has a priority date of April 8, 1971, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 148.9 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Big Blue River at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Township 10 North, Range 3 East of the 6th P.M. in Seward County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.07 cfs from all points of diversion (480 gallons per minute).

3. Appropriation A-12215 provides additional water to land approved for irrigation under appropriation A-2992.
4. On May 1, 2013, Vernon D. Curtis filed application EXT-4673 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-12215 and map number 18493 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-12215 through transfer EXT-4673.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-4673 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 18493 are APPROVED.

2. Appropriation A-12215 through transfer EXT-4673 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 148.9 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 18493, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from the Big Blue River at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Township 10 North, Range 3 East of the 6th P.M. in Seward County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.07 cfs from all points of diversion (480 gallons per minute). The total combined volume of all appropriations may not exceed 3 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year.

3. Appropriation A-12215 through transfer EXT-4673 provides additional water to land approved for irrigation under appropriation A-2992 through transfer EXT-4675.
4. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-12215 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
5. A measuring device approved by the Department is required.
6. This appropriation is subject to the provisions of the Blue River Compact and could be closed if Compact flows are not being met.
7. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
