APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-3466 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-17373

WATER DIVISION 2-C

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-17373 is held by Rayder and Katherine K. Swanson.
2. Appropriation A-17373 has a priority date of June 6, 1994, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 177.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Niobrara River at points of diversion located on the west bank of the stream in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Township 32 North, Range 6 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Knox County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 2.53 cfs from all points of diversion.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:


1. Application EXT-3466 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 18387 are APPROVED.
