ORDER COMBINING APPROPRIATIONS A-17723A and A-17723B AND

APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFERS EXT-2109 and EXT-2110

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriations A-17723A and A-17723B are held by Bradley E. Cromwell.
2. Appropriation A-17723A has a priority date of October 27, 1938, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 121 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Beaver Creek at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 14, Township 17 North, Range 4 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Nance County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 98 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 1.23 cfs (552 gallons per minute).

3. Appropriation A-17723B has a priority date of October 27, 1938, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 38.8 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Beaver Creek at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 23, Township 17 North, Range 4 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Nance County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 98 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.40 cfs (180 gallons per minute).

4. On May 17, 2011, Bradley E. Cromwell filed application EXT-2109 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-17723A.
5. On May 17, 2011, Bradley E. Cromwell filed application EXT-2110 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-17723B.
6. On May 17, 2011, Bradley E. Cromwell filed map number 17862 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-17723 through transfers EXT-2109 and EXT-2110.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Appropriations A-17723A and A-17723B are combined into a single appropriation A-17723.
2. Applications EXT-2109 and EXT-2110 for permits for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 17862 are APPROVED.
3. Appropriation A-17723, through transfers EXT-2109 and EXT-2110, authorizes the use of water to irrigate 159.8 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 17861, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from Beaver Creek at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 14 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23 both in Township 17 North, Range 4 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Nance County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 98 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.63 cfs from all points of diversion (732 gallons per minute).

4. Appropriation A-17723 provides additional water to appropriation A-2983.
5. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-17723, A-17723A, and A-17723B remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.

6. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
  - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION


Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.





