APPROVAL OF MAP 17842 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18770

BACKGROUND

On April 12, 2011, Clayton Olsen filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18770 for a Permit to Appropriate Water and map number 17842 showing land proposed to be irrigated under this application.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17842 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18770 as depicted on map number 17842 which is made a part of this Order.



3. Appropriation A-18770 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 63 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from South Blackbird Creek at points of diversion in the NW¹/₄NE¹/₄ and the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄ of Section 16, Township 23 North, Range 9 East of the 6th P.M. in Burt County, at a maximum combined rate of 0.90 cubic foot per second (cfs) (404 gallons per minute) from all points of diversion.
4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18770.

Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure* 454 *Neb. Admin. Code* Chapter 7. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (4th Floor, Nebraska State Office Building, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
