APPROVAL OF MAP 18293 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18958

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On August 13, 2012, Jeffrey P. and Marjorie S. Hoier filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18958 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On August 27, 2012, Jeffrey P. and Marjorie S. Hoier filed in the Department map number 18293 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18958.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18293 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18958 as depicted on map number 18293 which is made a part of this Order.



3. Appropriation A-18958 has a priority date of August 13, 2012, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 68.7 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from New York Creek at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄ and the NE¹/₄SE¹/₄ of Section 6, Township 19 North, Range 11 East of the 6th P.M. in Washington County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.98 cfs from all points of diversion (440 gallons per minute).

4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18598.
