APPROVAL OF MAP 18419 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19016

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On January 24, 2013, Steve Nordby, on behalf of Velma Nordby, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19016 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On April 3, 2013, Velma Nordby filed in the Department map number 18419 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19016.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18419 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19016 as depicted on map number 18419 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 30 North, Range 1 East of the 6 th P.M. in Cedar County	Acres
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Section 25: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	40.3
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	40.4

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3. Appropriation A-19016 has a priority date of January 24, 2013, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 176.5 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Kerloo Creek at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 30 North, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M. in Cedar County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 2.52 cfs from all points of diversion (1,131 gallons per minute).

4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19016.
