ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-9825B

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-9825B is held by Gregory D. and Erin L. Stunkel.
2. Appropriation A-9825B has a priority date of May 23, 1960, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 4 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Mud (Beaver) Creek at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 15 North, Range 18 West of the 6th P.M. in Custer County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.06 cfs.

3. On June 26, 2013, Gregory D. and Erin L. Stunkel filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-4748, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-9825B for use upon the land described above.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-9825B is CANCELLED.
