APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-2442

FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18307

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-18307 is held by Kerwin Elting.
2. Appropriation A-18307 has a priority date of May 10, 2005, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 159.2 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 4 North, Range 7 West of the 6th P.M. in Nuckolls County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 2.27 cfs from all points of diversion (1,019 gallons per minute).

3. On November 13, 2012, Kerwin Elting filed application EXT-2442 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-18307.
4. On November 27, 2012, Kerwin Elting filed map number 18358 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-18307 through transfer EXT-2442.
5. Construction has been completed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-2442 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use, and map number 18358 are APPROVED.
2. Appropriation A-18307 through transfer EXT-2442 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 159.2 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 18358, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 4 North, Range 7 West of the 6th P.M. in Nuckolls County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 2.27 cfs from all points of diversion (1,019 gallons per minute).

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-18307 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. This appropriation is subject to the provisions of the Blue River Compact and could be closed if Compact flows are not being met.
5. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
