APPROVAL OF MAP 18756 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19072

BACKGROUND

1. On April 22, 2013, Curt A. Wischmeier, on behalf of the Curt A. Wischmeier Living Trust, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19072 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On December 18, 2013, Jay Wischmeier, on behalf of the Curt A. Wischmeier Living Trust, filed in the Department map number 18756 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19072.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18756 is APPROVED.
2. The following is a description of all the land which is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19072 as depicted on map number 18756:

Appropriation A-19072 authorizes the appropriator the use of 100.3 acre-feet annually from Wischmeier Reservoir (storage appropriation A-19071) from a pump site located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20, Township 3 North, Range 9 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Pawnee County, with the permission from the appropriator of A-19071, Jay K. and Rosemary Wischmeier, Trustees, to divert water for irrigation from this reservoir.

4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19072.
