APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-4841 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-8480

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-8480 is held by the Austin Family Revocable Trust.
2. Appropriation A-8480 has a priority date of April 14, 1956, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 22.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River at points of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 2 North, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M. in Jefferson County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.16 cfs from all points of diversion.

3. On October 15, 2013, Joel Austin, on behalf of the Austin Family Revocable Trust, (Applicant) filed application EXT-4841 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-8480 and map number 18698 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-8480 through transfer EXT-4841. The Applicant indicated that the only active point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 2 North, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M. in Jefferson County and therefore, is the only location of diversion depicted on map number 18698.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-4841 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 18698 are APPROVED.

2. Appropriation A-8481 through transfer EXT-4841 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 22.0 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 18698, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 2 North, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M. in Jefferson County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.16 cfs (72 gallons per minute). The total volume may not exceed 3 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year.

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-8480 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. This appropriation is subject to the provisions of the Blue River Compact and could be closed if Compact flows are not being met.
5. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
