APPROVAL OF MAP 17407 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18661

WATER DIVISION 1-D

Background

1. On April 22, 2009, Matthew J. Young filed application A-18661 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On April 28, 2009, Matthew J. Young filed map number 17407 showing land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-18661.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17407 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18661 as depicted on map number 17407 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 9 North, Range 3 East of the
6th P.M. in Seward County Acres

Section 11: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 0.1

3. Appropriation A-18661 is held by Matthew J. Young and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 0.1 acre of land described above. The water may be diverted from Coon Creek at a point of diversion in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 9 North, Range 3 East of the 6th P.M. in Seward County at a maximum rate of 0.001 cubic foot per second (cfs) (0.4 gallons per minute). The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated and an annual volume not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18661.
